Print one copy for use during the Come On In Activity. After children have colored the Lesson Review Coloring Sheets, they will tape them on the board as you describe briefly what occurred in the lesson. See script below.

LESSON 8

Jesus was about to go back to heaven. Before He left, Jesus promised His followers that God would send them the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit would help the disciples remember all the things that Jesus taught them. God sent the Holy Spirit to the disciples on a special day called Pentecost. There was a loud sound like the rushing of a mighty wind! Then something like fire came on all of the people in the room. This was the sign that the Holy Spirit had come! He would help the disciples and give them something special called “fruit.” Everyone who has the Holy Spirit in him will have the fruit of the Spirit!

LESSON 9

The Holy Spirit gave the apostles special power to teach and heal people in the name of Jesus. But there were a lot of people who did not love Jesus. They hated Jesus. They hated the disciples of Jesus. But Jesus’s disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit. They loved Jesus. They wanted to tell everyone about Jesus—even if that meant they got in trouble.

LESSON 10

God wants others to learn about Jesus. He sent Philip, a disciple of Jesus, to tell an Ethiopian man about Jesus. Philip met the man on a road far from his home. He told the Ethiopian man all about Jesus. The man listened and believed! He wanted to be baptized in the name of Jesus right away! The Ethiopian was from another nation. God wants all nations to hear about Jesus!

LESSON 11

Jesus’s followers would not stop talking about Him! This made Saul very angry! He wanted to destroy the Christians. But God had a different plan. Saul met Jesus on the road to Damascus. There was a bright light, a voice from heaven, and Saul fell to the ground! The Bible tells us that after meeting Jesus, Saul was changed forever! He heard the voice of the Lord! Saul became a Christian and leader of Jesus’s church. He would preach the gospel to anyone who would listen.

LESSON 12

Peter was a Jew. Cornelius was a Gentile. Jews and Gentiles did not talk to each other. But God wanted the Gentiles to hear the good news about Jesus. Peter told Cornelius that all people are special to God and can believe in Jesus. Peter shared the good news of Jesus with Cornelius and his family. They believed the gospel and became Christians! The good news is for everyone!
